

SCICN Care Coordination Program

If you are living with a complex or chronic health condition, you might be eligible to participate in the Care Coordination Program of Southern California integrated Care Network (SCICN).

This free, personalized program can help you improve and maintain your health with self-management techniques and coordination with your individual support team.

Participation is completely voluntary. However, you may be identified by a healthcare professional as someone who might benefit from these services.

Patients that meet the program criteria will likely have one or more of the following:

- Two or more chronic conditions
- Multiple chronic or high-risk medications
- Multiple emergency department visits and/or hospitalizations
- Social barriers – for example, living alone without care-giving assistance
- Other identified needs

We will not use or disclose your health information for anything but care coordination purposes. Any additional use will require your written authorization.

- Access resources or programs that you need
